### **Hip Hop Is My Passport – A Bridge Between Cultures**

*Morganics is an award winning Hip Hop artist. He has performed from Bondi Beach to Tanzania & taught in jails, community centres and isolated Aboriginal communities.*

In a one hour session I will perform a rap in 15 languages, freestyle, breakdance, teach the history of Hip Hop culture, perform a spoken word piece (slam poem) & show a small selection of video clips from my travels & work with communities across the globe.

As a Hip Hop community worker I have been lucky to work with street kids in Tanzania, in high schools in NY City, perform at festivals in Czechoslovakia & Canada. I have also run workshops in remote Aboriginal communities & with refugee & disabled groups.

Having worked in jails across Australia - most recently Parkville Juvenile Jail in Melbourne - as well as Rijkers Island in New York, I will show how Hip Hop can be used as a positive tool for young people to get their lives on track.

I also have extensive experience in addressing issues such social justice, bullying, cyber bullying & racism if requested – *Morganics*.
